

Confidence for Anxious Times

One of our members, Janet Matthews, shared the following Noah's Ark story, "A Family in Lockdown," with me. I am presenting it here in a slightly edited version:

40 days, 40 nights in the Ark, Noah's family was confined in a boat. There was no internet, no phone, no TV, no Youtube, Facebook or Netflix. They only heard the rain. They spent their time praying, loving each other and caring for the animals. God the Father took care of them as Noah was a man of faith and believed

His word. Remember even though there is out there an ocean of viruses and life seems like a stormy ride, our God is watching over us. Do not be afraid! Trust in the Lord and wait patiently.

The rain will stop one day. A rainbow will shine and all will be well again.

That story is meant to give us patience and courage in the face of unprecedented times for most of us. The Coronavirus pandemic is an invisible enemy. One source writes that it is confronting us with the four stages of fears: anxiety, worry, fear, and panic. It is causing so many changes in our daily routines, social distancing and all. There is much uncertainty here at church, too, as exactly how to proceed with planning. Even as write, we are not sure that Holy Week and Easter services can go on as scheduled. It seems doubtful. Right now we


Recently, a read a devotion by Rev. Mark Schroeder, our SED Facilitator for Mission Engagement. Excellent. I share only a brief portion of it her. He writes about a Bible verse that had great meaning for his late wife:

> Over the years and to this day that verse comforts me. What was the verse? It was Deuteronomy 31:8, "The Lord himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor

forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged." (NIV)

Dear people of God at Christ congregation:

It is my responsibility as your Circuit Visitor to assist you, and especially your Call Committee, in the process of calling the next pastor to serve and lead Christ congregation in its God-given ministry and mission. This is undoubtedly both an exciting and unsettling time for you. And while the *process* is a human development, it is designed to help you discern God's will regarding who will be your next pastor. Therefore, although it is a humanly developed process, it is a *holy* activity.

While my involvement in this is primarily with your Call Committee, there is a very important encouragement I would like to share with and impress upon all of you. It is the following, which is quoted from the document provided by the Southeastern District for the guidance of congregations in the calling process: "Out of respect for the candidates [that is, those pastors on your Call List] and their current congregations, all communication and contact with the candidates should be by/ through the Call Committee. Members [of the congregation] are encouraged to trust the Call Committee to do its work."

Finally – and this is critical: surround your Call Committee with prayer.

From the Chairman of the Call Committee, Michael Younghouse:

UPDATE on Call Committee: The Call Committee has met twice along with Pastor Quackenboss. We have discussed the calling process with him and have gone over the manual sent by the Southeastern District for our congregation. The following pastor names are being submitted to District: Anton Lagoutine, David Ludwig, Elliott Robertson, Glenn Roseman, Michael Staneck, Robert J. Stevens, Richard Tucker.

From the SED President, John Denninger: Relevant to our congregation: After the congregation has completed its Congregation Profile and has asked for nominations from the congregation and a subsequent call list from the District President, it would be good to pause the process at this point.

Here's the reason why: As soon as the Call List is given to the congregation, the Circuit Visitor is instructed to call the candidates on the Call List asking if there is any reason why the pastor might not be able to deliberate a call at this particular time. Many pastors would legitimately respond that on the basis of the pandemic they would not be able to deliberate on a call should the congregation call them. Your call list will likely be decimated even before you start the next phase of the process.
